Oregon Opportunity Grant: for college students with demonstrated financial need

Oregon Promise Grant: for high school seniors and GED recipients entering community college within six months of graduation

Chafee Education and Training Grant: for current and former foster youth

Oregon Student Child Care Grant: for parents pursuing a postsecondary education

Outreach and Resources

ASPIRE: mentoring program for middle school, high school and college students to develop a plan for meeting their college and career goals

FAFSA Plus+: program to share data with K-12 schools and other agencies, to support students with FAFSA completion
