2021 \$3,000

1. Any student may apply for this scholarship, which is not limited in any way by sex, race, religion, national origin, creed or color.
2. Scholarships are limited to tax supported **public institutions** of **higher education or certified trade or apprenticeship programs in the state of Oregon.**
3. Applicants should have a 3.0 or better grade point average.
4. Applicant must be a good student, prompt with assigned tasks and should show promise of completing at least two years of a specific educational program. The applicant should have a neat appearance.
5. Applications **MUST BE IN** the counselor's office by April 15, 2020.
6. **The counselor or scholarship coordinator of the high school will screen applicants as necessary and send 3 candidates to the selection committee not later than April 23, 2021.**
7. The Eugene Lodge scholarship committee will select winners in early May 2020.
8. Scholarships MAY be presented at a dinner meeting hosted by Eugene Masonic Lodge No. 11 at the Lodge Building on Wednesday, May 19, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.
