
Wearing a Face Covering at Elmira

Keeping Everyone Safe






Wearing a face covering at school is required and is important to keep students, staff, families and yourselves safe.







Everyone at school will be wearing a face covering.



If you do not have a face covering, the school will give you one to wear while you are at school.



Try to keep your hands off your face covering. If your face covering gets wet or dirty, ask your teacher for a fresh face covering.



Even when you are wearing your face covering, try to stay six feet away from teachers and staff.









It is important to wear your face covering on the bus, in the hallways, using the restroom and at recess.





You do not need to wear a face covering when you are eating or drinking.



Your teacher will have a space for you in class to take a short break from wearing your face covering.

Covers only your mouth and nose


Loops stay around your ears

Covering stays over your mouth



Wearing a Face Shield

Covers your whole face Stays in place on your face Wear the shield the way it was meant to be worn





If you need to sneeze or cough, leave your face covering on. Throw any tissues in the garbage. Please wash your hands or use hand sanitizer after.
