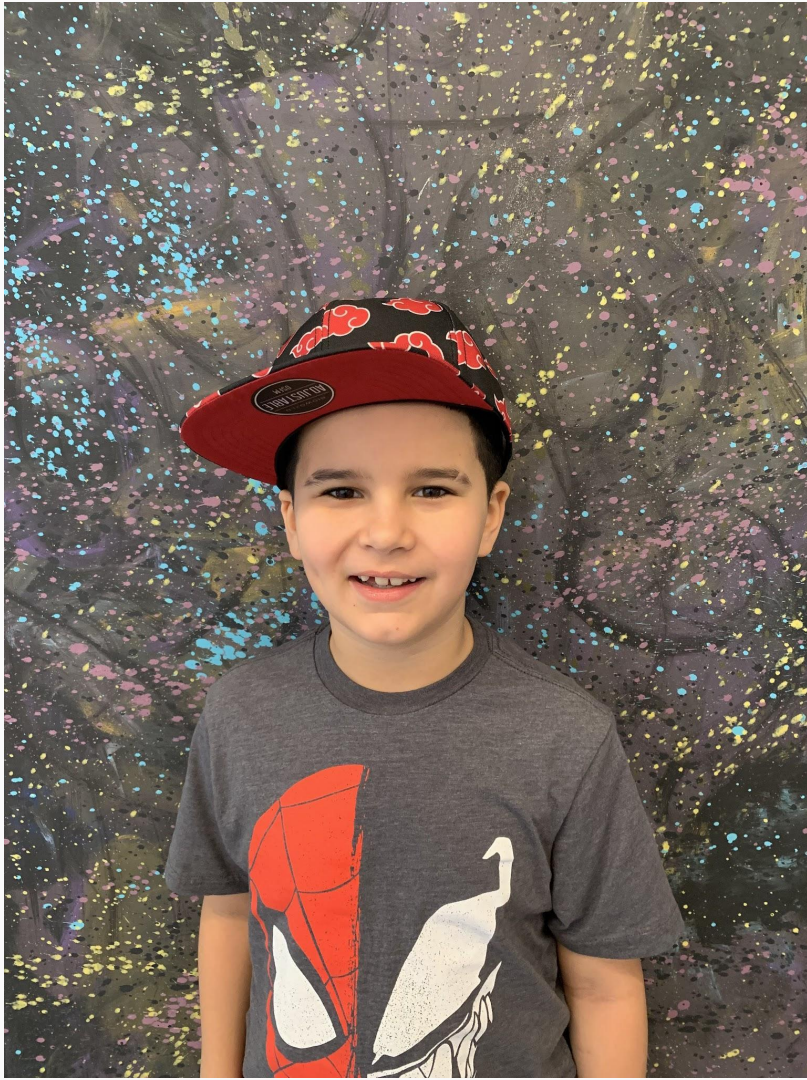


Bayler
