Find an expert in your area

Find a local professional or volunteer who can help you enroll. The free help can be offered in person or by phone. Find an agent storefront where you can get help from a local storefront agent. These health insurance agents have contracted with the state to provide help with outreach and enrollment. You can also contact us.

- Health insurance agents – Certified professionals who can give advice about which plans may be best for you and help you enroll.
- Medicare agents – Certified professionals who can give advice about which Medicare plans may be best for you and help you enroll.
- Community partners – Community organizations that can help you enroll but cannot give advice about plans.
- Medicare volunteers – Volunteers who can help answer Medicare questions and help with the enrollment process.
- COFA Premium Assistance Program – Certified professionals who can give advice about which COFA-eligible plans may be best for you and help you enroll.
