

ELMIRA HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION FAQs:

How do I get a cap and gown?

Order forms/packets are available in the Registrar's Office.

When do I receive my cap & gown?

Cap and gowns are delivered to the school and handed out in May at a senior class meeting.

Can I modify my cap?

Yes – with prior administration approval.

Who is my walking partner?

Students indicate who they plan to walk with on a sign-up sheet in the front office the last 2 weeks of school.

Is there graduation practice?

Yes. Graduation practice are the two days prior to graduation night at 9:00 a.m. and are REQUIRED for all graduates who participate in the ceremony.

What if I need handicap seating for family planning to attend graduation?

If you need handicap seating for family, indicate the number of seats to the registrar and accommodations will be made in an area set up for handicap seating.

How many tickets do I receive for family to attend the graduation ceremony?

Each graduate receives 4 tickets for reserved floor seating. However, there is unlimited bleacher seating.

What time do graduates need to arrive the night of graduation?

Graduates need to be at the school by 6:30 p.m.

What time does the ceremony begin?

7:00 pm
