2. Applications are due May 27, 2020. Completed applications can be emailed to Mrs. Ellis, returned to the school, or shared with Mrs. Ellis on Google Drive (using the above email address).
3. Candidates will be notified no later than June 1, 2020, about the acceptance of their application.
4. If a candidate's application is accepted, a copy of the candidate's speech will be mailed home and/or posted into Homeroom Google Classrooms by June 1, 2020.
5. Individual campaigning is strongly discouraged. Please be mindful that not everyone will have the same access to campaigning technology. Current Leadership students will promote the upcoming elections but will not endorse an individual candidate.
6. Voting will take place the first week of June. All votes must be submitted by June 5, 2020. Ballots will be accessible to the student body in Homeroom Google Classrooms via Google Forms or printed ballots sent home for those with limited technology access. Printed ballots can be returned to the school along with distance learning packets.
7. Candidates who are elected to office will be notified the following week of June and their duties will begin at a time in August for planning, to be determined at a later date. Candidates who did not receive enough votes for the position they were seeking can either fill an open position via a special election in the fall or remain in the course as a member-at-large. This decision must be communicated to Mrs. Ellis by the last day of school, June 12, 2020.
