Hustler Mag v Falwell (1988) Free Expression; parody ad suggesting Falwell incest w/ mother, Flynt convicted of causing emotional distress

Flynt argument: murder is illegal, but take a picture of it and you may wind up in Time Magazine. Sex is Legal, but take a picture of it and you may wind up in jail.
