



Assistance League® of Eugene Children's Dental Center

The **Children's Dental Center** provides free dental care for low-income, school-age children whose families lack dental insurance. Students must be referred to the Dental Center through their school nurses or health aides.

Because the **Children's Dental Center**, 1850 Bailey Hill Rd. #10, Eugene, OR, is not a "walk-in" clinic, appointments must be made through the Center's dental assistant.

- The **Children's Dental Center** is open by appointment Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays during the school year, September through June. The hours are flexible to accommodate our **volunteer dentists and hygienists**.
- The Center serves children ages 5-18 years old in Eugene 4j, Bethel, Springfield, Junction City, Pleasant Hill and Fern Ridge school districts.
- Over the last five years the **Children's Dental Center** saw, on average, 500 patients per year.
- The Center provides general dentistry. Difficult extractions, root canals, etc., are referred out of the Center.
- Dental professionals may volunteer in their offices as well as at the Dental Center.
- A dental hygiene kit is given to each child at the initial visit to encourage good dental care habits.
- The program is funded by our "assistance league Thrift Shop", 1149 Willamette St., Eugene, OR, and by grants to Assistance League and through the 4j school district.

The Center has recently moved to a remodeled facility on the Churchill High School campus, 1850 Bailey Hill Rd. #10, Eugene, OR.

The **Children's Dental Center** opened in 1995 and is one of seven philanthropic programs supported by Assistance League of Eugene, a 501(c)(3) organization. Assistance League volunteers serve as receptionists.
