

Instructions for Accessing Home Access

Your one stop website for grades, attendance, discipline and more!!!

Step one: Navigate to the Fern Ridge School District website at: www.fernridge.k12.or.us

Step two: Click on “Fern Ridge Middle School” (left hand side of screen).

Step three: Click on “HOME ACCESS CENTER”

A login ID is created for anyone who is listed as “guardian” on your child’s school information. You will be able to check who is listed as a “guardian” once you are logged in.

Your login ID could be set up three different ways:

1. First Name (period) Last Name, i.e., John.Doe
2. First Initial (period) Last Name, i.e., j.doe
3. First Initial Last Name, i.e., jdoe

If none of these work, please contact the school. We apologize for the inconsistency in setup.

Your password will be your student’s five digit school number and their date of birth in

this format: MMDDYYYY. For example, if your student’s number is 12345 and their

date of birth is November 13, 1997; your password would look like: 1234511131997

Click the “login” button.

Once you are logged in you will see your student’s name in the upper right hand corner of the screen. If you have more than one student at the middle school and/or high school, there will be a “change student” button. Clicking on this button will allow you to select which one of your students’ record are viewed. There are six “buttons” about 1/3 of the way down the website.

They are titled “Home,” “Attendance,” “Classes,” “Grades,” “Student Support,” and “Registration.”

The “Home” button will reveal your child’s schedule and work assignments. The “Student Support” button will reveal discipline incidents. I believe the remainders of the buttons are self-explanatory.

We strongly advise you to change your password to something only you know the first time you log in. You change your password by clicking on your name in the upper right hand corner; you will see “My Account.” Click on “My Account” and find the area that says, “Change Password”. Enter your old password where indicated, then enter your new password where indicated. Lastly, it will ask for a confirmation of your new password. When completed, a message pops up that says, “Your password has been changed successfully”.
