It will be different! New rules mean lots of changes.


FRMS Hybrid is going to look and feel different than our regular school model. Due to the COVID pandemic, there are new rules in place that schools have to follow.

Before we could reopen, we had to submit a plan to the state on how we will meet these new rules. To stay open, we have to continue to follow our plan and follow these new rules.



The Big Three Rules for COVID Prevention



Always Wear a Mask that covers nose, mouth, and chin



Always social distance by staying 6 feet apart



Always use hand sanitizer or wash hands throughout your day

The two **BIG** Changes

1. In FRMS Hybrid, students will attend school two days a week. You will come either Tuesdays/Thursdays or Wednesdays/Fridays.


On your non-school days, you will use Google Classroom to check into your class and get your assignment for the day. Make sure you do the attendance question for each class or you will be marked absent.

2. You will have six classes. In FRMS Hybrid, we will add a sixth "elective" class to your schedule. The "elective" will be assigned to your cohort instead of you choosing the "elective."



What to Expect When You Get To School

- 1. Each grade will have an assigned entrance/exit.
- 2. When you enter, you will be asked how you are feeling and visually checked for signs of illness. If you are not feeling well, let the screener know.
- 3. Once in the building, you will go directly to your cohort classroom.
- 4. **No lockers!** You can take your backpack to your class.
- 5. No breakfast at school. You will get to take home a sack when you leave that has breakfast for the "At Home" day and a breakfast for you to eat before coming to school on your next school day.



Grade Level Entrances and Exits

6th	Front Entrance	
7th	Side Entrance from Patio to Commons	
8th	Side Entrance by Rm 18 (Mr. Davis's classroom)	

What will my classroom be like?



Fewer desks! About 15 students in each cohort.

Rotating teachers! Teachers will move from class to class while the cohort stays the same.

You will be asked to sign in and out each time you leave the room. You will have to have a Hall Pass.

You cannot share school supplies with other students. If you need something, let us know.

You will have an assigned seat.

Rooms will have hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies.

What about P.E.?

Mrs. McBride will teach 6th grade P.E.

Mr. Newman will teach 7th and 8th grade P.E.

We will not use the locker rooms and you do not have to change clothes for P.E.

You should dress for P.E. everyday by wearing clothes that are comfortable to move around in and shoes you can run and jump in.

Sixth graders will have their P.E. separate from 7th and 8th graders.



Masks must still be worn during P.E. whether class is inside or outside.

What about lunch?



No one has to pay for a school lunch this year

"At School" lunches will come with a hot entree in a sack. Utensils and condiments will already be in the bag.

There will only be one entree choice each day. Lunch menus for the month will be on the website.

We will have two eating locations- the Commons and a second eating area in the weight room.

Fun fact: The weight room used to be the cafeteria back in the old days of FRMS. Mr. Stoe's classroom has also been the cafeteria in the past.

"At Home" lunches will have a cold entree.

More Stuff About Lunch



Social distancing required when eating.

Masks can be taken off when eating or drinking but then must go back on. Make sure your mask stays with you when you aren't wearing it.

You must sit in a designated spot and remain seated until told to throw your trash away.

After you eat, you will get a chance to hang out in the Commons or go outside. One week your cohort will hang out in the Commons and the next week they will go outside.

Last Words About Lunch




You will need to use hand sanitizer before lunch and after lunch.

You can not share personal belongings which can include cell phones, water bottles, basketballs, etc.

You must use the bathroom in the Commons at lunch.

Drinking fountains will be available, but the water bottle filler feature will not be.

No sandwich bar or food cart.



Library

Because of COVID restrictions, the library will not be open to students before school or at lunch.

The library will not be available for individual students to use.

Your teacher may take your whole class to the library to check out books or do research.

Our wonderful librarian, Brenda, will still be part of the FRMS staff and help in other ways.

The library will return after COVID.



When the last bell rings!

Cohorts will be dismissed by an announcement over the intercom.

Teachers will walk students to the buses.

Social distancing and masks on.

There will be assigned seats on the buses.

No bus passes this year.

While you are waiting to get picked up or waiting for the bus, you must still social distance and wear masks.



Final Thoughts

- Masks must be correctly worn all day, inside and outside
- Social distancing must take place everywhere at school and on the bus
- If you are sick, stay home. If you start to feel sick at school, let your teacher know.
- On your "At Home" days make sure you check into Google Classroom for each class, do the attendance question, and complete the work posted for that day.
