Summer Learning Camp FAQ

- 1. **How many students will attend?** 14 students at each grade level have been invited. Class size for language arts, math, and the just for fun elective will be 7. Field Activities will be in groups of 14.
- 2. **Will there be transportation**? Yes. Once we get our lists finalized and we know who our 14 students that will be attending are, we will give that list to the bus barn and they will start working out routes.
- 3. When is Summer Learning Camp? Summer Learning Camp starts on July 12th and goes till August 5th for a total of 16 days. It will be Mondays thru Thursdays only from 9:30 to 1:00.
- 4. **When is lunch?** Lunch will be served onsite. Students can bring a lunch from home or get a lunch from school. Make sure you check the box for a school lunch on the form.
- 5. What will the day look like? We have divided the day into four parts plus lunch. Students will take Language Arts and Math each day. They will also have a Field Activity class outside each day- where they will play field games like Frisbee Golf or Field Hockey. Finally, each student will have a just for fun class which may be an arts and craft project, or painting, or a STEM activity, etc. We are planning for a different activity class each week.
- 6. Why call it a Summer Learning Camp? We don't want these four weeks to look like or feel like a typical school experience. We want students to build skills in reading and math and just reengage where they may have disengaged over the pandemic. We also want them to have fun which is where the field games and the Just for Fun Activity Class come into to play.
- 7. **What if we have a family vacation planned?** We want students to be at the Summer Learning Camp every single day if possible. We know that 100% attendance might not be possible for all students, but they shouldn't miss more than a few days of the 16 day session. Any more than that, and they miss critical instruction. If the family vacation is going to have them out of Summer Learning Camp for a week or more, it might be good for your child to not to come to camp, to give their spot to someone on the wait list, and to enjoy their family vacation.
- 8. **Will there be COVID restrictions?** As of 5/24/21, we expect that students will have to socially distance and wear masks inside the building with no masks required outside for field activities. That may change as the guidance changes. We will notify families of any changes.
