We are so excited to provide some fantastic and fun activities for students K-12 over the next 4 weeks.

Health and Safety Protocols that will be followed during our Super Summer Program:

- Things will look much like they did at the end of the school year.
- While the Governor has reduced requirements and restrictions state-wide, both the OHA and ODE use the language of “strongly advise” schools to continue to follow safety protocols like masks and social distancing.
- We will continue with staff and students wearing masks indoors. Masks are not required outdoors.
- We will social distance as much as possible, as in the case of a positive person being on campus, all close contacts must quarantine/isolate as directed by Lane County Public Health. The definition of a close contact is being within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes. Social distancing will still be emphasized.
- To reduce mask time, we will have multiple opportunities for classes and activities to be outside during the summer programs.
- Students riding the bus will be required to wear masks.
