<p>Text Messages on the Remind app</p>	<p>VES regularly sends out text messages to inform parents about special events and happenings. To get text messages, simply text the message @68d3g2 to the number 81010</p> <p>For more information, check out the VES Text Messages link on our website.</p>
<p>Website/Email</p>	<p>Our website is filled with information about our school and is updated regularly with information about what is going on at school. When we post something to the website it automatically gets emailed to all parents.</p> <p>http://www.fernridge.k12.or.us/venetaele/</p>
<p>School Newsletter</p>	<p>We have a monthly school newsletter that goes home with students. A copy of the school newsletter is also available on our website and in the front office.</p>
<p>Reader Board</p>	<p>Check out our reader board for reminders about important events like Open House.</p>
<p>Auto-Dialer</p>	<p>The school district has an automatic phone dialing system that is used to communicate with families. It will call the number listed as your child's home number.</p>
<p>Classroom Communications</p>	<p>Teachers communicate with families on a regular basis. Some do this through a classroom newsletter, some through email, and some through a classroom text message list. Contact your child's teacher directly for more information.</p>
<p>PALS Facebook Page</p>	<p>Our parent group PALS (Parent Action League for Students) has a Facebook Page. They post information from the school as well as information about PALS events. Just search Veneta PALS to find it.</p>
<p>PALS Website</p>	<p>Our parent group has a website that explains who they are, what they do, and how you can get involved. Visit venetapals.org and check it out!</p>
