(6) Each School Building must have a written plan for response to medical emergencies; such plan should be articulated with general emergency plans for buildings and districts as required by OAR 581-022-2225.

Elmira High School (EHS):

The Fern Ridge School District maintains an Emergency Plan Handbook that is updated annually. Each building and classroom maintains a current copy. One item in the handbook is how to respond to a medical emergency. It is on page 23 of our handbook. Handbooks are reviewed at the beginning of the year staff meetings, and on an ongoing basis by building safety committees. The plan specifically addresses when to call 911, how to assess the scene, and how to assess the victim.

In addition, all building have AED's and staff trained to use them. Locations of the AED's are reviewed and known by all staff.

At the High School only, each athletic team also maintains an Emergency Action Plan (EAP). This plan is updated each season, with roles being identified and assigned to new team members.
