Paul is our Student of the month for December.

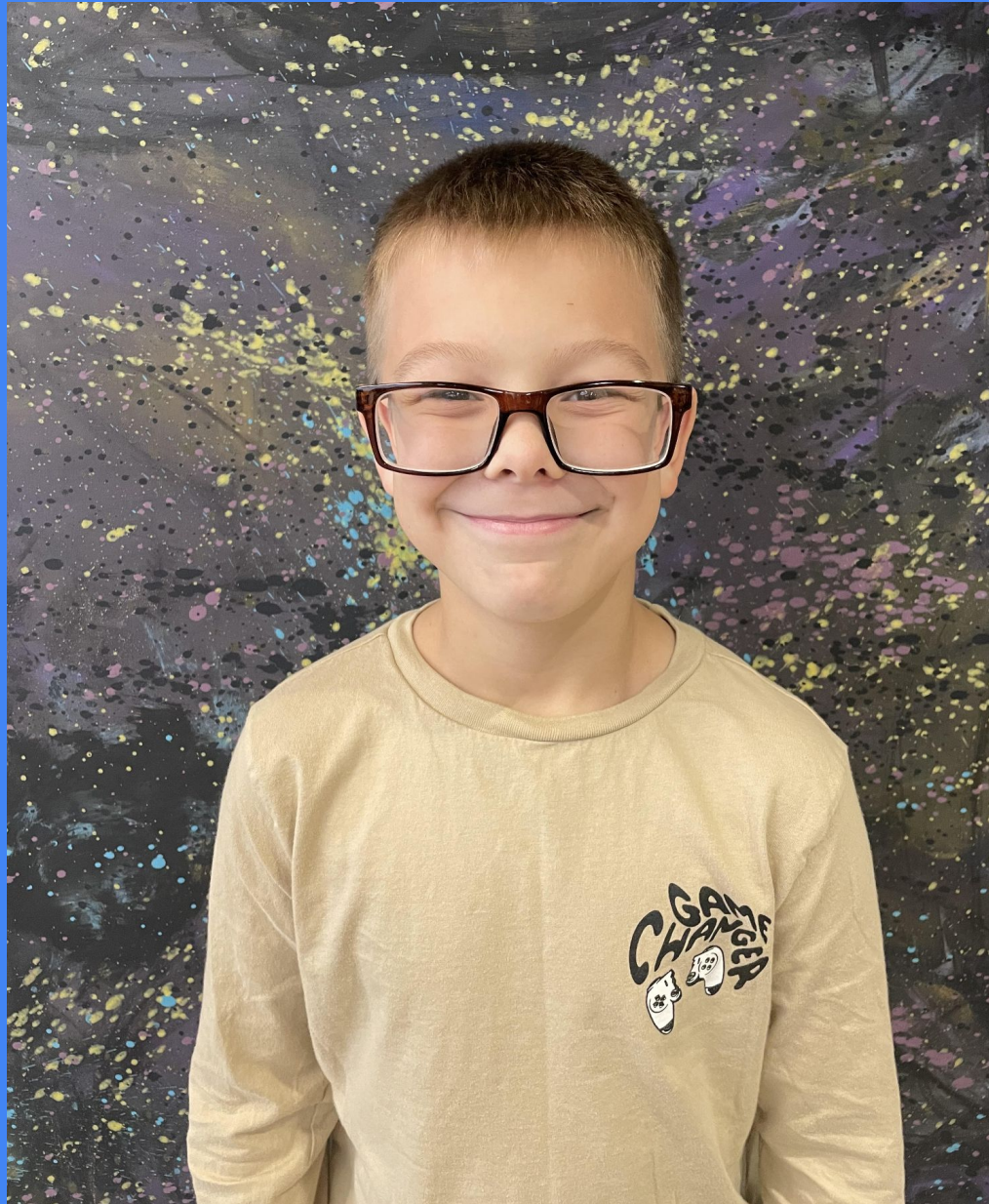
