#### FRSD TECHNOLOGY STUDENT USE AGREEMENT

The Fern Ridge School District (FRSD) views the use of technology as a great way to promote engagement, learning, innovation, communication, and collaboration amongst our students. It is important for our students to learn how to navigate and manage these resources in order to help pave the way for success both now and in the future.



In order to provide access to these resources, FRSD makes every effort to ensure that devices and software are maintained and accessible to our students. In turn, we expect students to demonstrate appropriate use of district technology resources. This document outlines expectations for the responsible use of student technology. We ask that parents/guardians read through this document and consider your role in supporting the responsible use of district technology. Please review and discuss this document with your student(s).

## **District Responsibilities:**

- The District will provide access to a device that is in satisfactory working order. For K-8th students, it will be provided on an as needed basis. For high school and OPTIONS, a device will be assigned to each student.
- The District will facilitate the repair of non-functional or damaged devices. For EHS and OPTIONS, please see the device protection plan included in your packet for information regarding accidental damage.
- The District will provide access to software or online digital applications per educational requirements.
- School staff will monitor student use of district technology while in-district.
- The District has the ability and sole discretion to monitor usage of our various technology systems and will pull reports for investigative purposes when necessary to do so.

#### Parent/Guardian Responsibilities:

- Encourage your student to exercise responsible use of district technology.
- Monitor student use of technology when being accessed away from school.

#### **Student Responsibilities:**

- Use FRSD technology for its intended purpose to support and enhance learning.
- Follow all laws and FRSD policies in the use of District hardware and software, including copyright laws. For additional information regarding general district technology policies, please review the following resources:

- Accounts are assigned to individuals and may not be shared. This means that students will not let others use their account to access the Internet or any FRSD technology resources.
- Students are to protect their own safety and the safety of others by never revealing their personal address and phone number or those of other students or staff members.
- District technology may not be used for unlawful purposes or to download, order for print, or
  otherwise transmit or communicate any material that is obscene, offensive, pornographic,
  sexually suggestive, deceptive, harassing, threatening, menacing, abusive, harmful, an invasion
  of privacy, defamatory, libelous, violent or hatred against another person or group of persons
  with regard to race, color, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion, national origin, age,
  marital status, disability, or other protected classes.

- District technology may not be used for commercial purposes, advertising, personal financial gain, or political campaigning.
- Students are not to modify technology equipment (hardware or software) without permission. Applying stickers to devices is prohibited.
- Any deliberate attempt to degrade or disrupt technology performance by spreading computer viruses is considered criminal activity by state and federal law.
- EHS & OPTIONS: Students in our one-to-one device program are responsible for covering the cost of any damages incurred to the device. The District understands that unintentional damage does occur. For that reason families are strongly encouraged to sign up for the device protection plan. Please carefully review the "Elmira High School & FRSD Options Device Protection Plan" in your packet for more information.

Access to FRSD technology is considered a privilege accorded at the discretion of the Fern Ridge School District. The district maintains the right to immediately withdraw access when there is reason to believe that violations of law or district policies have occurred. In such cases, the alleged violation will be referred to the principal for further investigation and account restoration, suspension, or termination.

Fern Ridge School District makes no warranties of any kind, whether expressed or implied, for the service it is providing. The District will not be responsible for any damages a user suffers including loss of data resulting from delays, nondeliveries, mis-deliveries, or service interruptions caused by the district's own errors or omissions. Use of any information obtained via the Internet is at the user's own risk. Fern Ridge School District specifically denies any responsibility for the accuracy or quality of information obtained through its services.

# Elmira High School & FRSD Options Device Protection Plan



Fern Ridge School District is committed to helping students grow in both their understanding and usage of technology. We believe that technical knowledge and digital responsibility go hand in hand. Our EHS and OPTIONS one-to-one take-home device program is designed to provide every high school student with a Chromebook in order to access their online digital curriculum. Having a fully functioning device is essential for accessing our academic courseware and it is important that students take proper care of their Chromebook. We recognize that sometimes accidental damage does occur and that is what the Device Protection Plan (DPP) is designed to cover.

#### Plan Summary:

- Annual Cost: \$20/device (Max cost of \$60 per family)
- Covers any accidental damage to the Chromebook during the course of the school year. Repair
  costs of repeat damage or anything the district determines to be caused by gross negligence,
  will be handled on a case by case basis.\*
- This plan will NOT cover any missing or lost items such as the charger or the device itself.
- This plan does NOT include replacement of the Chromebook case.

We strongly recommend that families enroll in our optional DPP program. If the DPP fee creates a hardship for your family, please reach out to your administrator for payment options. Declining to enroll in the DPP program means that you will be responsible for all hardware repair costs not covered under warranty, whether accidental or otherwise. ALL repairs must go through the district via our authorized repair service company. Please DO NOT attempt to repair any damages yourself.

\*For students who enroll in our summer school program, this plan also covers the device during the summer school term.
