

FRSD STAFF CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

Custodial staff will:

Ensure bathrooms have running water, soap and paper towels

Increase cleaning of “virus hot spots” (door knobs, toilet handles, light switches, hand rails etc.)

Assist in make extra disinfecting supplies available in the school offices and healthrooms for use in classrooms or common areas.

Administration will:

Closely monitor information provided by local and state public health authorities and other organizations such as OSAA.

Distribute updated, pertinent information to staff and families as needed. This may be via email, social media, phone dialer or district website.

Make plans in the event there is a case diagnosed locally. This may include possible school closure, restrictions of activities, extensive cleaning of buildings and investigation by health professionals. Ways to communicate this type of event will also be planned.

Make staff and students aware of recommendations below

All staff and students should:

Report any bathroom facilities that are out of soap or paper towels or if the water isn't working properly.

Assist in enhanced cleaning efforts by obtaining disinfecting supplies from our custodial staff or the office so that staff can spray high-touch areas and horizontal surfaces in their classrooms, offices, or work spaces as needed.

Stay home if they are sick and contact their health care provider if they have questions about their symptoms.

Wash hands frequently with soap and water. If soap and water aren't available, use alcohol based hand sanitizer.

Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth as this creates a direct pathway for germs to enter the body.

Properly and completely cover coughs and sneezes. Immediately discard any tissues used.

Consider changing greetings such as high fives or handshakes to something like thumbs up or air high fives.
