

DIRECTORY INFORMATION ANNUAL NOTICE

District Policy JOA states the district should annually notify parents of students in attendance, the types of information considered to be directory information. Parents should be aware of the requirement that the district must, by law upon request, release secondary student's names, addresses and telephone numbers to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education, unless parents or eligible students request the district withhold this information.

Directory information means those items of personally identifiable information contained in a student education record which is not generally considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released. The following categories are designated as directory information and may be released to the public through appropriate procedures: Students name, address, telephone listing, electronic address, photograph, date and place of birth, participation in sports and activities, weight and height of athletic team members, dates of attendance, grade level, degrees/honors or awards received, and most recent previous school or program attended.

Page 6 of the annual student handbook ([LINK HERE](#)), outlines this requirement and identifies the way a parent can request their directory information or personally identifiable information NOT be released.
